

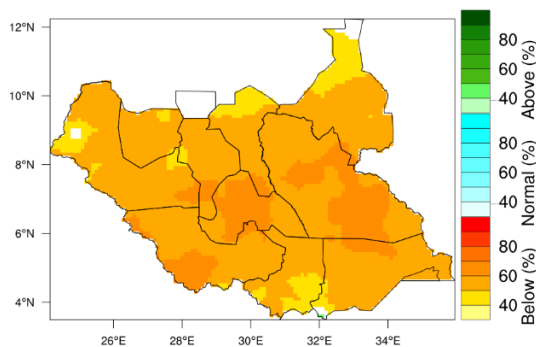
MONTHLY FORECAST FOR JULY 2026

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SUMMARY

- July 2026 rainfall is expected to be drier than normal across most of South Sudan.
- The Temperature forecast for South Sudan indicates that warmer-than-normal temperatures are expected across most parts of the country during July 2026.

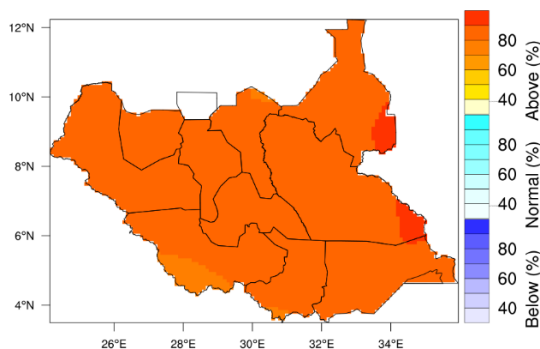
Rainfall Forecast for July 2026



The July 2026 monthly rainfall forecast indicates an increased likelihood of below-normal rainfall over South Sudan. With 80% (dark orange-red color) over the southern parts of Western Equatoria,

northern Eastern Equatoria, most parts of Pibor Administrative Area, South and Central parts of Jonglei State, most parts of Lake State, southern parts of Unity & Warrap States and Southeastern parts of Western Bahr el Gazal State, with probabilities reaching 60% over most parts of the country. While 40% (Yellow color) is expected over Southern of Central Equatoria, Nimule in Eastern Equatoria, El Renk in Northern of Upper Nile State, Ruweng Administrative Area, Abyei Administrative Area, and Raja in Western Bahr el Gazal State.

Mean Temperature Forecast for July 2026



The July 2026 temperature outlook indicates a strong likelihood of above-normal temperatures across South Sudan. Most parts of the country are forecast to experience warmer-than-average conditions, with probabilities exceeding 80% in many areas. The strongest signal for above-normal temperatures is forecast over the southeastern Pibor Administrative Area and southeastern Upper Nile State (Red color)
